

# Boil Water Advisory

Date: May 23, 2015

#### 1. Purpose of the Lessons Learned Report

Boil Water advisories (BWA) are not issued often by water purveyors. Due to the nature of conditions that generate the need for a BWA and the weight of both state and federal regulations regarding follow-up actions and notification requirements, BWA can be difficult to manage and mistakes and omissions may lead to compliance issues and strained customer relations.

Therefore, a comprehensive review of the District's policy and procedures related to BWA after an event will assist management in identifying areas where the policies and procedures work well and areas where additions, deletions, or revisions of policies and procedures may be warranted.

This report will be based on input from management, field superintendents, and the Board. The goal of this exercise will be to identify areas that work well and areas were improvements can be achieved. Emphases will be placed on building on what works well and improving on what did not work well. There is nothing to be gained by assigning blame for any weakness identified in the current policies and procedures or application thereof.
