On February 15, 2019, the North Beach Water District received eight bids for the Bay Avenue Water Main Project. The bids ranged from \$506,293.92 to \$933,081.37. The Engineer's Estimate was \$579,361.95. Each proposal was checked for correctness of extensions of the prices per unit and the total price.
