A. Rate Study Discussion

B. South Wellfield Pilot Study

The general manager gave a presentation to the board on the pilot study that took place in early July at the South Wellfield.

There was discussion between the board and the general manager on the pilot study.

The general manager shared that the company doing the pilot study, ATEC, needs to come back and run further tests and that will run anywhere between \$30,000 to \$40,000.

There was further discussion on this issue.

Commissioner Sheldon made a motion for the general manger to move up to \$40,000 from the Capital Reserve Account to go into the pilot study.

Commissioner Ripley seconded that motion.

Commissioner Ripley called for a vote.

The vote to transfer funds from Capital Reserve to our Operations Account to pay for the pilot study passed unanimously.

A. Possible New Lawn Mower Purchase

There was discussion between the board and the general manager regarding the purchase of a new lawn mower.

The general manager shared that we are trying out several different mowers to see what would fit best for our district.

The general manager will report back to the board when a decision on a mower is made for approval.
